

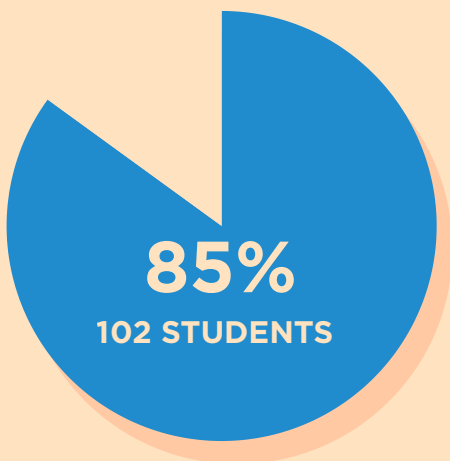
# 21ST CCLC GARFIELD MIDDLE SCHOOL BOYS & GIRLS CLUB

## ENROLLMENT AND ATTENDANCE

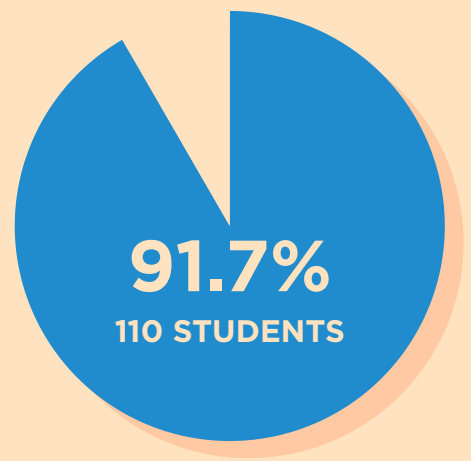
2025-2026

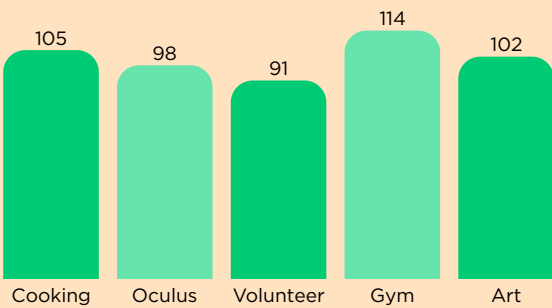
### STUDENTS WITH 30+ ATTENDANCE DAYS

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

### COSMETOLOGY



The goal of this program is to educate students on self-care, explore different aspects of beauty—including fashion, editorial, TV, and pageant—and inspire innovative ideas for special effects. By the end of the program, each student will gain experience, skills, and confidence to perform skincare, nail care, and makeup application independently.



### SNEAKER DESIGN



In this class, students explore sneaker design by learning about style, materials, colors, and trends. They sketch, customize, and create their own sneaker concepts, building creativity and design skills. Students also participate in a Nike design challenge, with the winning sneaker featured on Nike's official website.



### ARCHITECTURE / INTERIOR DESIGN



This course introduces students to architecture and interior design through hands-on projects. Students will practice space planning, read architectural drawings, and design their own homes and rooms using recycled materials. By the end of the course, they will gain creativity, confidence, and a basic understanding of architecture and design principles.
